

LEFT HANDED FENCER

Hand positions are used to rotate the weapon.

The six hand positions are created by the rotation of the hand through degrees of pronation and supination.




The following diagrams represent the thumb (black dot) and guard, and show the hand positions as seen from the perspective of the fencer holding the weapon.




Pronation LH: hand rotated fully clockwise RH: hand rotated fully anticlockwise
